1.5 DELIVERY, INSPECTION, STORAGE, AND HANDLING

1.5.1 Delivery

Herbicide material shall be delivered to the site in the original, unopened containers bearing legible labels indicating the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) registration number and the manufacturer's registered uses.

1.5.2 Inspection

Seed shall be inspected upon arrival at the job site by the Contracting Officer's Technical Representative for conformity to type and quality in accordance with paragraph MATERIALS. Unacceptable seed shall be removed from the job site.

1.5.3 Storage

Materials shall be stored in areas designated by the Contracting Officer's Technical Representative. Seed shall be stored in cool, dry locations away from contaminants. Herbicide materials shall not be stored with other materials.

1.5.4 Handling

Except for bulk deliveries, materials shall not be dropped or dumped from vehicles.

1.26.13 Seeding (OPTION J)

1.26.13.1 Payment

Item No. 0013 (OPTION J), "Seeding (Seed Mixture in accordance with paragraph 2.1.2.1 k.);" payment will be made for all costs associated with furnishing and sowing the specified additional Option J seed with the base seed mixture.

1.26.13.2 Measurement

The number of acres of additional Option J seed actually sown and accepted within the 144 contiguous laid-out and staked acres. No payment will be made for additional Option J seed sown outside of the laid-out and staked area.

1.26.13.3 Unit of Measure

Unit of measure: **acre**.

1.27 SEQUENCING OF WORK

Layout and survey of the prairie reconstruction area by the Government shall be completed not later than March 25. The Illinois Department of NaturalResources will perform a burn of the project site between March 11 and April 1. The Contractor will be notified by the Contracting Officer's Technical Representative of the burn completion the next business day. Two herbicide applications shall be performed. The first herbicide application shall not occur prior to three weeks after the burn. The second herbicide application shall not occur until two weeks following the completion of the first herbicide application. Sowing of seed shall begin 7 days following the second application of herbicide treatment. Mulching of seeded areas shall be accomplished on the same day seed is sown. Provide sequencing of work as part of herbicide treatment and seeding plan.

PART 2 PRODUCTS

2.1 MATERIALS

2.1.1 Herbicide

- a. Comply with Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (Title 7 U.S.C. Section 136) for requirements on the Contractor's licensing, certification, and record keeping.
- b. The entire site shall be treated with ROUNDUP UltraMAX (EPA Reg. No. 524-512), as manufactured by Monsanto Company, St. Louis, MO, telephone: 800/332-3111.

2.1.2 Seed

It is preferred that seed be an Illinois ecotype, grown in Illinois. All seeds shall be furnished from an established seed dealer or established seed grower. Seed shall be provided in original sealed packages bearing the producer's guaranteed analysis for percentages of purity, germination, hard seed, weed seed content, and inert material. Labels shall be in conformance with **AMS-01**

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and applicable state seed laws. The seed analysis on the label shall be mechanically printed. If it is necessary to store the seeds after their arrival on the work site, they shall be stored in an approved cool, dry, weatherproof enclosure in such manner as to protect the seeds from deterioration. The seed shall be guaranteed by the vendor to be true to botanical name and variety.

2.1.2.1 Seed Mixtures

The seed mixture shall be proportioned by weight. Common names are provided but the botanical name will govern. The minimum seed mixture shall contain at least:
