The following items are applicable to this modification:

AMENDMENT VERBIAGE

Prior to the Contractor commencing operations at the site, the Illinois Department of Natural Resources will accomplish a burn of the site to be treated, seeded, and mulched.

3.2.2 Herbicide Treatment

- a. The first herbicide treatment shall be applied at the rate of 2.5 quarts per acre. The second herbicide treatment shall be applied at the rate of 1.75 quarts per acre. Apply herbicide in accordance with the manufacturer's label. Special attention shall be given to the timeliness of herbicide application. Herbicide shall be applied evenly and uniformly over the entire work site. See also Paragraph 1.27.
- b. A separate CEMVR Form 55-E, "Pesticides Application Record Sheet", must be completed for each day herbicide is applied. A copy of CEMVR Form 55-E is attached at the end of this section.
- c. Copies of the completed CEMVR Form 55-E's shall be provided to the Rock Island District Pesticide Coordinator, Ms. Theresa Duvall, CEMVR-OD-T, through the Contracting Officer's Technical Representative upon completion of the project.
- d. The Contractor shall closely coordinate herbicide application with the Contracting Officer's Technical Representative and notify the Contracting Officer's Technical Representative at least 24 hours in advance of the dates, times, and areas of herbicide applications.
- e. If rainfall occurs within 6 hours after application, the treatment shall be repeated at the Contractor's expense. Herbicide shall only be applied when vegetation is free of visible moisture, from any source. Herbicide shall be applied with due consideration to the protection of vegetation outside of the treatment limits, trees inside and outside of the treatment limits, and all water bodies. Mixing water shall be clean and free of sediment.
- f. Person(s) applying herbicides shall be licensed, commercial applicator(s) with the appropriate category license for the product being applied. *
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3.3 SEEDING AND MULCHING

Prior to starting work, mulch applicators and seeders shall be calibrated and adjusted to apply mulch and sow seeds at the required seeding rate. Work shall be performed in a manner that will provide the Contracting Officer's Technical Representative the opportunity to verify the quantity of material furnished and the rate of application.

3.3.1 Seeding

- a. Seeding dates shall be from April 22 to May 31, when the ground is friable from frost action. Method of application shall be hydroseeding.

b. Equipment shall be operated in a manner to ensure complete coverage of the entire area to be seeded. The Contracting Officer's Technical Representative shall be notified 48 hours prior to beginning the seeding operations so that the Contracting Officer's Technical Representative may determine by trial runs that a calibration of the seeder will provide uniform distribution at the specified rate per acre.
