Sponsor interest in cost-sharing the study scope of work has waned. The study is currently inactive.

Description

The project location includes the area along River Drive/US 61 and is bordered by Marquette Street on the east to Fairmount Street, on the west from Rockingham Road on the north to the Mississippi River on the south. This area includes a major industrial area as well as a brownfield area and residential area on the west. The project location also includes Black Hawk Creek from Telegraph Road to its mouth on the Mississippi River. The City of Davenport envisions this location along River Drive/US 61 to serve as an aesthetically pleasing entryway into the City of Davenport. The City desires to: Improve the aesthetics of River Drive, create expanded and improved green space, consider possibilities of berming/buffering land uses to improve flood protection and consider alternative uses of Davenport Harbor.

To complete this study, the focus will be on two defined subjects: a hydrology/hydraulic analysis and an action plan for the area based on the analysis. The study area will incorporate engineering feasibility analysis for greenways and functional improvements along the River Drive/ US 61, overland storm water and floodplain analysis.
