Status

Red Rock Lake and Dam is operating with reduced capabilities and closures of some areas due to flood damage. Flood Control Facilities are partially functional. Limited funding for flood damage recovery has been received. Damage Assessments for Flood Control, Environmental Stewardship and Recreation and are just starting as on the week of September 2, 2008.

Description

Lake Red Rock is a multiple purpose project providing primary benefits in flood control and low-flow augmentation and secondary benefits in recreation, fish and wildlife management, forest management, and water quality improvement. Conservation pool is 15,600 acres which makes it lowa's largest lake; and the storage volume is 1,750,400 acre-feet at flood pool level. The dam is located on the Des Moines River southeast of Des Moines, lowa. Cumulative damages prevented since project's inception (1969) = \$531,600,000. The project includes 50,300 acres of fee title lands and there are 11 recreation area sites. FY07 recreation fee receipts and lease revenues were \$459,792. Regional economic impact of project visitation is \$11,300,000.

The Red Rock Dam and Lake project experienced major flooding during Spring and Summer 2008. The flooding caused extensive damage to facilities, buildings and grounds.
