Geographic extent of study area modified consistent with sponsor desire to voluntarily fund study cost. Study is physically complete and financially closed out.

Description

The Corps conducted a hydraulic and hydrologic analysis of Wolf Creek in LaPorte City, Iowa. A HEC-RAS model developed by the Corps for the watershed was reviewed and updated. The 1% chance (100 year) and .02% chance (500 year) flood boundary limits were delineated. A floodway boundary was computed and delineated. Mapping was provided to the city along with support in processing Letter of Map Revision (LOMAR) submittal to FEMA.
