Terminated due to project being on continuing hold for contaminant cleanup.

## Description

Sedimentation and poor water quality has lead to a degraded environment for fish and wildlife in a backwater area of the Illinois Waterway. The opportunity exists to restore aquatic and wetland habitat. Project planning for a Section 206 project was started but was suspended due to the presence of PCBs and other containments from the Old LaSalle Dump which is adjacent to the project site. Several agencies and organizations to include the Corps, the US EPA, the IL EPA, the State of Illinois, City of LaSalle are working to identify and remove toxic substances prior to the initiation of the Section 206 project planning. The Section 206 project has been terminated until the contamination is cleaned up and meets US EPA standards.
