Status

MVR has been assigned as the USACE liaison for the Interagency Levee Working Group (ILWG) for the states of Illinois and Iowa. Daily and weekly meetings and review coordination of all levee activities are ongoing.

Description

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers has a lead role in the development of a collaborative regional approach to the short-term and long-term restoration of flood management systems damaged by the Midwest Floods of June 2008. The Corps is working with the Federal Emergency Management Agency and other federal, state and local agencies to assemble a Regional Interagency Levee Task Force (ILTF) to provide a uniform approach across the region impacted by the Midwest floods.

Interagency Levee Work Groups will operate in state Joint Field Offices to review assistance requests from local entities, evaluate non-structural alternatives (creation of expanded floodways and ecosystems), and participate in the levee restoration process.
