

Coralville Lake Day User Fee Program

Not An Entrance Fee

The day user fees at boat ramps and beaches are not entrance fees. Only those visitors actually using a beach area or launching a watercraft will be charged a fee. Visitors to a launch ramp will not be charged a fee just to park a vehicle. Visitors will not be charged for other recreational activities such as hiking, bird watching, sightseeing, picnicking, etc.

Daily Fee

Payment of the daily user fee, which ranges from \$1 to \$4, allows you to use all similar Corps day use facilities on that day. Save your receipt when you leave an area. If you return to the area or visit another area the same day, just show your receipt. A staffed entrance station or self-registration depository is available for payment of the daily user fees.

Annual Fee

If you are a frequent user of Corps boat ramps or beach areas, you may wish to purchase an annual pass for \$30, instead of paying a daily fee with each visit. The annual pass allows unlimited, nationwide use of all Corps day user fee areas for 12 months from date of purchase. The pass is in the form of a hang tag, which is hung from the vehicle's interior, rearview mirror.



Where to Buy Your Annual Pass

Annual passes may be purchased at the Coralville Lake Administration Office or at any campground or day use area entrance station during the recreation season. For your convenience, annual passes may also be purchased by mail; simply complete and mail the enclosed order form with your payment.

America the Beautiful Passes

The passage of the Federal Lands Recreation Enhancement Act of 2004 created a new discount program for Federal agencies called America the Beautiful Interagency Pass Program. The legislation does not authorize the US Army Corps of Engineers full involvement in this new pass program. The Corps of Engineers will not be authorized to sell or otherwise issue the new passes for this new program. The Corps of Engineers will accept the new America the Beautiful Senior Pass and the America the Beautiful Access Pass for the 50% discount. The Corps of Engineers will still continue to accept the old Golden Age and Golden Access Passports.
