Cost

Whitebreast Coal Miner’s Retreat shelter costs \$75.00 plus a security damage deposit of \$100.00. If a special use permit is required, the security damage deposit will be \$250.00

Availability

Whitebreast Coal Miner’s Retreat enclosed shelter is only available by making a reservation through the Lake Red Rock Project Office. The outdoor picnic area may be used without a reservation when the enclosed shelter is not in use.

Reservations may be made Monday through Friday 7:30am to 4:00pm.

WHITEBREAST DAY USE AREA MINER'S RETREAT ENCLOSED SHELTER AREA RULES

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers maintains and operates this enclosed shelter for the benefit of day-use groups wishing to reserve this facility for various events. Special regulations apply for the rental of this facility. Your cooperation in complying with these rules will insure future use of this facility.

Information about this facility or general information about Lake Red Rock is available from Park Rangers or the Visitor Center. Please report any problems you may encounter in the recreation area. Our goal is to make your visit a pleasant one.

1. The Miner's Retreat enclosed shelter in the Whitebreast Day Use Area is available by reservation only. The shelter can be reserved for use during the hours of 8:00 AM to 9:00 PM. Overnight occupancy in the enclosed shelter is prohibited.
2. A non-refundable \$75.00 fee will be charged for the enclosed shelter per day. There is a \$100.00 security damage deposit required. If a special-use event permit is required, the security damage deposit is \$250.00.
3. Reservations may be made for the current calendar year through the Lake Red Rock project office. Payment for the reservation request must be received at the project administration office within 14 calendar days of the request to insure confirmation. Payment for reservations that are requested 7 days or less prior to the event must be received by noon on the last business day before the event. If the reservation fee is not received within these time frames, the facility will be considered available for others requesting its use. Paid shelter reservations will be accepted on the day prior to the event on weekdays until noon on Friday.
4. Unusual activities may require a special event permit. This determination is the responsibility of the operations manager or his designee.
5. An inspection of this facility will be performed prior to your use and before your departure. Please leave this facility in a clean and orderly condition. Upon vacating, all personal items should be removed from the building. Any items left in the building after your departure will be disposed of.
6. **Absolutely "NO KEGS"** are allowed in the area.
7. Ground fires must be confined to fire rings.
8. **Absolutely "NO PETS"** are allowed inside the enclosed shelter. All pets in the area must be on a leash no greater than 6 foot.
9. All vehicles must remain on the roadways and/or designated parking lots. Any vehicle parking in the Whitebreast Beach parking lot is subject to the Day-Use fee.
10. Any member(s) of your party that may use the Whitebreast Beach area are responsible for all applicable Day Use fees.
11. A group camping in the Agency campground may also be using the immediate area. Please be considerate of these groups during your stay.
12. Keys for this facility will be issued to your party by a volunteer or park ranger. Late season users may be required to unlock and lock the main entrance gate for this area.

All Corps regulations not covered here applies to the area. Copies of these regulations are available from Park Rangers or the Visitor Center.
