Availability

Shelters may be used any time during the year; however, water and electricity are only available during this shelter's open season. **Mid April – Early October**

Shelters at Lake Red Rock are always available on a first come first served basis unless a reservation has been made through the Lake Red Rock Project Office.

How to Reserve

Reservations may be made Monday through Friday 7:30am to 4:00pm.

- Type of activity
- Will the event be open to the public?
- Will there be a fee charged?
- Will there be alcohol available?
- Will there be any music?
- How many people will be attending?
- Who will be the responsible person for the event?
- Address and phone numbers of the responsible person(s)
