### Howell Station Landing

#### Features

Howell Station Landing has two lanes.

Parking is available for approx. 29 vehicles with trailers attached in the paved lot.

Howell Station Landing does not have a courtesy dock.

Howell Station Landing is located on the river below the dam.

#### Day-Use Fees

U.S. Army Corps of Engineers managed boat ramps such as South Overlook, Marina Cove, Whitebreast, Howell Station Landing, and the Wallashuck high-water boat ramp all require payment of a daily use fee of \$3.00 unless posted otherwise.

Registered campers from U.S. Army Corps of Engineers managed campgrounds are not required to pay day-use fees at beaches or boat ramps if displaying a camping pass found at campground fee booths.

#### Annual Pass

Purchasing an Annual Pass permits a visitor to use U.S. Army Corps of Engineers managed swimming beaches and boat ramps without further charge for one year.

Annual Passes can be purchased for \$30.00 at U.S. Army Corps of Engineers managed campground fee booths or the Lake Red Rock Project Office.

#### Discounts

Golden Age/Access and America the Beautiful Senior/Access card holders may use beaches and boat ramps or purchase an Annual Pass for half-price.
