Cost

Whitebreast Coal Miner’s Retreat shelter costs \$85.00/day.

Availability

Whitebreast Coal Miner’s Retreat enclosed shelter is only available by making a reservation through the NRRS system. The outdoor picnic area may be used without a reservation when the enclosed shelter is not in use.

How to Reserve

If you would like to reserve this shelter for your event, please visit www.recreation.gov or call 1-877-444-6777. This shelter may only be reserved for use during the hours of 8:00 AM to dusk.

You may need to have a special event permit if:

- Number of people attending event is greater than 100.
- Event is open to the public (open to members of the general public outside your organization).
- Alcohol will be available to the attendees.
- Event involves live or amplified music.
- A fee is charged to the attendees.

WHITEBREAST DAY USE AREA MINER'S RETREAT ENCLOSED SHELTER AREA RULES

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers maintains and operates this enclosed shelter for the benefit of day-use groups wishing to reserve this facility for various events. Special regulations apply for the rental of this facility. Your cooperation in complying with these rules will insure future use of this facility.

Information about this facility or general information about Lake Red Rock is available from Park Rangers or the Visitor Center. Please report any problems you may encounter in the recreation area. Our goal is to make your visit a pleasant one.

1. The Miner's Retreat enclosed shelter in the Whitebreast Day Use Area is available by reservation only. The shelter can be reserved for use during the hours of 8:00 AM to dusk. Overnight occupancy in the enclosed shelter is prohibited.
2. Miner's Retreat costs \$75 per day. If customers change or cancel their reservation, they will be charged a \$10 service fee. If customer cancels reservation within 14 days of the scheduled arrival date, they will forfeit the total day use fee with no service fee charge. This is according to the NRRS reservation policy.
3. Reservations must be made through the NRRS reservation system. Visit www.recreation.gov, or call 1-877-444-6777.
4. An inspection of this facility will be performed prior to your use and before your departure. Please leave this facility in a clean and orderly condition. Upon vacating, all personal items should be removed from the building. Any items left in the building after your departure will be disposed of.
5. Ground fires must be confined to fire rings.
6. **Absolutely "NO PETS"** are allowed inside the enclosed shelter. All pets in the area must be on a leash no greater than 6 foot.
7. All vehicles must remain on the roadways and/or designated parking lots. Any vehicle parking in the Whitebreast Beach parking lot is subject to the Day-Use fee.
8. Keys for this facility will be issued to your party by a volunteer or park ranger.
9. All Corps regulations not covered here apply to the area. Copies of these regulations are available from Park Rangers or the Visitor Center.
