## Project Location Information

**Location:** Along Rock Island County Highway 64, (320th Street North) located along the Rock River south of Hillsdale, Illinois

## Status

The project is in the closeout stage. Coordination for the final crediting is ongoing with the sponsor.

## Description

Rock Island County is the non-Federal sponsor for the project. A letter requesting Corps of Engineers assistance was provided in September 1999. County Highway 64 is being threatened by erosion during high flow periods. The stability of the highway increases the need for emergency streambank protection at this location. The opportunity exists to stabilize the bankline and to protect the highway from further erosion. The project was constructed in late 2003.
