Description

Over the years sediment from the surrounding areas has contributed to a decrease in the depth of Canton Lake. In an effort to increase its water supply capacity the City of Canton has been working towards several objectives intended to increase capacity and decrease sedimentation at Canton Lake.

The City of Canton requested a Section 22 study to determine potential dredge material quantities and qualities. This effort would provide the city of Canton with data that is needed in their overall planning efforts to implement measures to improve the quality and quantity of water in Canton Lake.
