Description

This project is located in south east Polk County, Iowa including the watersheds of Spring, Camp and Mud Creeks. Several groups in this area are interested in creating a master plan for storm water and erosion control of Spring, Camp and Mud creeks. The Corps would conduct hydrologic and hydraulic analysis of the watershed and develop 2, 5, 10, 25, 100, 250 and 500 year flood profiles, flood boundaries and flood plain mapping to support a master plan for this watershed.
