## Description

A bridge listed on the National Historic Register is threatened by erosion on the North Skunk River. Further erosion will cause failure of the bridge. The North Skunk River is causing severe erosion of a bridge abutment in Powishiek County. If left untreated the bridge abutment may be lost. The opportunity exists to stabilize the bankline and to protect the bridge from further erosion.
