





## PUBLIC MEETINGS TO BE HELD

The UMR-IWWS Navigation Study announces a series of small public meetings along the study area. Fourteen meetings are scheduled from St. Paul, Minnesota to St. Louis, Missouri along the Mississippi River, and up the Illinois Waterway to Joliet, Illinois.

## MEETING PURPOSE

The purpose of the public meetings is to provide for an informative and educational exchange on study procedures, terminology, scope, and duration of the UMR-IWWS Study. We want to provide a good base of information to the public so you can better understand all the facets of the study. With the information provided, you can best determine how to participate in the study process.

## TARGETED AUDIENCE

The meetings are for anyone who is interested in the river, navigation, the Corps involvement with the river and the Navigation study.

We are encouraging local, state, and federal organizations and agencies, as well as public citizens, to join us at the meetings.

By having meeting locations one to two hours apart in drive time, you can decide whether or not these meetings are useful to you and worth your time to attend. The baseline of information

will be very general and should help in explaining how we have got to where we are and where this study may take us.

## SMALL MEETING FORMAT

Each meeting will be conducted by a representative of the UMR-IWWS Navigation Study Public Involvement team. The meeting will open with a formal welcome, introductions, and an explanation of the meeting purpose. This will be followed by a slide presentation outlining the river system, lock history, study scope, overview, and future outcomes. The slide presentation will conclude with a listing of options that interested persons will have to keep informed and/or become involved in the study as it progresses. This includes writing comments to the study manager, or contacting Governors' representatives, calling the toll-free 800 telephone system, and joining the mailing list to receive general and/or topic specific publications about the study.

The slide presentation will focus on the history of the locks and dams and the economic significance of the locks. We



The presentation will explain what the Feasibility phase is in relation to other project development phases, and what the Corps is proposing to do in the study. ### MAP INFORMATION


