

*** Individual campsites have a colored sticker on their site post to indicate price.

PRICE KEY: Yellow = \$10, non-electric; Orange = \$12; Blue = \$14; Green = \$16; White = \$18. The \$12 to \$18 prices, are base fees for a standard site with 30-amp electric service. There are a few sites priced from \$20 to \$24 (red sticker), which offer one or

more additional site amenities; 50-amp electric service, sewer hookup and/or water hookup. Bob Shetler and Acorn Valley offer a \$2 per night discount, Monday through Thursday.


