### Description

The project is located in Guttenberg, Iowa at the Guttenberg Landing just down stream from Lock and Dam No. 10 on the Mississippi River, (Approximately River Mile 614.5). The City would like to construct a marina around the current facility which consists of a concrete parking lot, boat ramp and a paved access from River Park Drive. The City of Guttenberg contacted the Rock Island District Corps of Engineers (District) to assist with preliminary planning efforts to construct a new marina.

The main objective for the District would be to provide a hydrographic, survey, mussel survey, wetland delineation survey and report, hydraulic and sediment analysis and soils analysis and data to the City of Guttenberg. The City will then have information needed to apply for construction permits.
