Whitebreast Youth Camp Rules

General Information

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers maintains and operates this area for the benefit of non-profit youth organizations. Any group meeting this qualification may reserve the area on a first-come, first-served basis. There is no charge for this area.

General information about Lake Red Rock is available from Park Rangers, campground fee booths, or at the Visitor Center. Special interpretive programming may be arranged by contacting the project's interpretation staff at the Project Office.

Please read and abide by the following rules which were made for your safety and the protection of the natural resources at the project. Also, please report any problems you encounter in the area so that we may take appropriate action to resolve them. Our goal is to make your visit a pleasant one.

Youth Camp Area Rules

- 1. Keys for the Youth Camp parking lot gate will be issued to your group by the area volunteer, the Whitebreast campground fee booth, or the project office.
- 2. Camping is permitted only in the mowed and maintained area.
- 3. Only dead wood on the ground can be collected for firewood. Do not destroy, deface, or otherwise injure any standing timber or other vegetation.
- 4. Quiet will be maintained between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. Visitors must leave the area by 11:00 p.m.
- 5. Fires are permitted only in fire rings, fireplace grills or charcoal burners. Fires must be extinguished prior to departing.
- 6. All pets must be kept on a leash under six feet in length or otherwise physically restrained. Pet waste must be removed and disposed of properly.
- 7. The possession of loaded firearms, bows and arrows, projectile firing devices, fireworks, and explosives of any kind are prohibited unless authorized by the Project Operations Manger.
- 8. The toilets provided at the site will be cleaned and supplied by the group using the area and will be left in a clean condition upon departure. Youth Camp users are permitted to use the shower buildings located within Whitebreast Campground.
- 9. Upon departing the area, all equipment and gear will be removed and the area cleaned of all litter. Litter and garbage will be removed from the area.
- 10. Unlicensed motorized vehicles are not authorized on the project. All ATV's, regardless of licensing, are prohibited. All motor vehicles must remain on the roadway and/or designated parking lot except as specifically permitted by a Park Ranger. Motorized vehicles may be driven into the Youth Camp area for loading and unloading purposes, but should be returned to the parking lot after loading or unloading is completed. One small "non-sleeping" storage trailer is allowed to be kept in the Youth Camp area for supply storage and cooking preparation.
- 11. No camping is allowed in the parking lot area.
- 12. The number of adult campers (counselors) allowed will be restricted to those necessary to conduct normal programming and insure the safety of the youth group involved.
- 13. Whitebreast Beach and Whitebreast Boat Ramp are day use areas available near the Youth Camp. Day Use fees are as follows: Beach fees \$2 per walk-in or bike-in with a maximum \$5 per personal vehicle (under 16 yrs. old free), Boat Ramp fees \$5 per day per boat trailer. Youth Camp users are not exempt from paying day-use fees.
- All U.S. Army Corps of Engineers regulations not covered here apply to the area. Copies of these regulations are available from Park Rangers or at the Visitor Center.
