- C. Additional comments to support AJD: Stream Stats showed a blue lined stream in one of the gullys/valleys where the pond would be constructed. A site visit was conducted to determine whether a jurisdictional stream was present. Once on site, the feature did not have enough indicators to be considered an ephemeral stream. It had banks but the bed was full of vegetation. The steep slopes of the area where the pond will be constructed did not suggest the presence of wetlands. The vegetative community did not change from the top of the site to the lower areas near the drainage feature. There is a creek on the back of the property, but the site where the pond will be constructed does not contain waters of the United States.

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
