- **B. Typical year assessment(s):** The US Drought Monitor shows that this portion of Clayton County is not in a drought or dry conditions. The APT tool shows that this area is wetter than normal.
- C. Additional comments to support AJD: As this site is mapped as a 100% hydric soil on the NRCS Web Soil Survey site, a site visit was conducted to determine if waters are present on site. One data point was dug. There was no evidence of hydrology or hydric soils. There is no other indication on any online GIS maps that there are waters on this site.
