Wetland A/Open Water Channel	0.57 acres	(b)(1) Surface water channel that does not contribute surface water flow directly or indirectly to an (a)(1) water in a typical year	This intermittent feature has an established bed and bank and the channel is marked with a blue line as an intermittent stream on USGS mapping. The stream ends in a residential storm water detention area with no connection to (a)1 – (a)3 water. Therefore, this intermittent feature is a (b)(1) exclusion: surface water channel that does not contribute surface water flow directly or indirectly to an (a)(1) water in a typical year.
