B. Typical year assessment(s): The US Drought Monitor shows this portion of Boone County in a Severe Drought, and the APT states that this area is drier than normal and in a Moderate Drought. This does not affect the AJD as there are no streams on or near the project site. There are only grassed waterways that these wetlands are connected to.

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C. Additional comments to support AJD: As no delineation/wetland determination was submitted, a field visit was conducted to verify if wetlands on site would be jurisdictional or not. There are no streams on site, and the surrounding properties were reviewed by aerial photography and by from the roads. There are no streams going in or out of the properties surrounding this AJD area.

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
